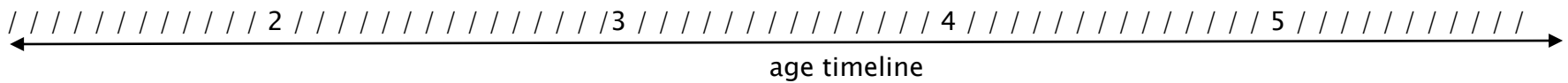


EARLY CLASSIFICATION DEVELOPMENT
